News & Prayer Update

It's been a few months since we last sent out a news update so we thought it was about time we let you know some news. We thank you for your prayers for us on a daily basis, just as we pray for you all every day. Last time we asked you to pray about a number of things -

- 1. Debbie now has a job working as a shop assistant. This is not particularly well paid and involves long and late hours but for now it is a job. She is still seeking something better and we would ask you to continue praying in that direction.
- 2. Peter has passed all his English exams and has been given the permit to teach English as a foreign/second language here. This has enabled him to take a job at a local language school, where he works most weekday mornings.
- 3. With regards the Christian School, we are progressing slowly. We are expecting to meet with the Minister of Education very soon to discuss our plans for the school and the Bible based curriculum we want to use. We would like to work towards starting the school in early 2015, one possible option which we are considering is beginning with English language for foreign students as Peter already has all the teaching permits for this, then we can add the other subjects/curriculum as the Lord provides both the resources and students.
- 4. The B&B project that Jayne wanted to start has been blessed with some guests already. Jayne writes about this on the back page.
- 5. We are actively involved in ministry through the Full Gospel Praise Centre. Peter is teaching every Sunday evening and every third week he preaches on Sunday morning. He also leads the worship at the evening meetings. Peter and Debbie have also regularly joined with a group from Holy Nation Church in London who come here to visit our neighbouring island for their Gozo4Christ missions.


Other Items
